

## How to move content from one shell to another in Moodle. *Faculty*

- 1. Click My Courses.
- 2. Open the course you would like to copy content from.
- 3. Click Settings.
- 4. Make note of the <u>Course short name</u> (must be exact).
- 5. Click **My Courses.**
- 6. Open the course you want to copy content to.
- 7. Click **More**→ **Course reuse**.
- 8. Enter the course short name from the course you want to copy content from.
- 9. Click **Search.**
